- The seriousness of problems posed by corruption may endanger the stability and secure of societies, undermines the value of democracy and morality and jeopardize social, economic and political development.
- There is a link between corruption and other form of crimes in particular organized crime and economic crime including money laundering.
- Cases of corruption especially on the large scale tend to involve vast of quantities of funds, which constitute a substantial proportion of the resources of the country effected, and that their diversion causes great damages to political stability and economic and social development of those countries.
